**Measure Description:**

Creates new manner of committing crime of assault in the fourth degree when person with criminal negligence causes serious physical injury to vulnerable user of public way by means of motor vehicle.

**Government Unit(s) Affected:**

Department of Justice, Department of Corrections, District Attorneys and their Deputies, Judicial Department, Oregon Criminal Justice Commission, Public Defense Services Commission

**Analysis:**

The proposed legislation has been determined to have
