## WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:

Creates limited landscape construction professional license that allows licensee to perform all phases of landscape construction work but limited to projects that individually do not exceed \$8,000 within any 12-month period. Exempts limited landscape construction professional licensee from examination and experience requirements.

#### **ISSUES DISCUSSED:**

# **EFFECT OF AMENDMENT:**

No amendment.

#### **BACKGROUND:**

Created in 1972, the State Landscape Contractors Board (LCB) licenses landscape contracting businesses and landscape construction professionals. Landscape construction professionals must meet experience and/or education requirements and pass a competency exam or practical skills test. The experience requirement can be satisfied with 24 months of employment with a landscape contracting business or at least 12 months of employment with a landscape contracting business with one full year of training in an area related to landscaping from an accredited school.

House Bill 3337 establishes a limited landscape construction professional license with no experience or education/examination requirements but limits scope of work to projects that do not exceed \$8,000 within any 12-month period.
