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**WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:**

Allows ports to advertise activities of the port and the activities of others using port facilities.

**ISSUES DISCUSSED:**

- Authority to advertise currently allowed by Oregon Revised Statute Chapter 777
- Activities and festivals held at ports, but not by ports themselves
- Process of bill creation

**EFFECT OF AMENDMENT:**

No amendment.

**BACKGROUND:**

Under current Oregon law, a port is allowed to advertise and promote the facilities and commerce of the port, but is not specifically allowed to promote its activities or the activities of others using the port.

House Bill 2900 would allow ports to advertise activities of the port and the activities of others using port facilities.
