Measure Description:

Increases penalty for crime of harassment if offense consists of subjecting another person to offensive physical contact and is committed in immediate presence of or witnessed by minor child in specified circumstances.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

District Attorneys and their Deputies, Judicial Department, Oregon Criminal Justice Commission, Public Defense Services Commission, Department of Justice

Analysis:

The proposed legislation has been determined to have
