WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:

Increases surcharge collected for the issuance of Crater Lake National Park registration plates from \$10 per plate to \$15 per plate.

ISSUES DISCUSSED:

- The need to support the Rim Village Education Center
- Crater Lake plate is the best selling specialty plate
- Anticipated to raise an additional \$260,000 in 2017-19

EFFECT OF AMENDMENT:

No amendment.

BACKGROUND:

Senate Bill 821 (2001) established the Crater Lake Registration Plates to commemorate the 100th anniversary of Crater Lake National Park. The proceeds from the sale of the registration plates are transferred to the National Park Foundation for use on Crater Lake National Park projects. Specialty plates such as the Police Memorial Trust Fund, University Logo plates, Salmon plates, and Trail Blazer plates are renewed every two or four years for \$32 or \$64 dollars. The Crater Lake plate and Pacific Wonderland plate have a one-time fee. Revenue, net of administrative fees, goes to entities identified on the plates.
