Measure Description:

Appropriates moneys to Housing and Community Services Department and Department of Land Conservation and Development to employ two full-time equivalent employees to perform services relating to increasing availability of affordable housing.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Department of Land Conservation and Development, Housing and Community Services Department

Analysis:

The bill provides a blank General Fund appropriations, in the 2017-19 biennium, to the Housing and Community Services Department and to the Department of Land Conservation and Development so each agency will employ one full-time position to provide assistance to stakeholders regarding the availability of affordable housing, and to aid in updating state resources relating to housing.

A more complete fiscal analysis on the bill will be prepared as the measure is considered in the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.
