Requires the Bureau of Labor and Industries to adopt rules in collaboration with groups that advocate for low income individuals to require employers to provide notice to employees of the potential availability of the earned income tax credit. Requires the Employment Department to provide information to recipients of unemployment insurance benefits of the potential availability of the earned income tax credit.
