Measure Description:

Establishes Small Donor Funded Elections program to enable candidates for state office to receive 6-to-1 match on small dollar donations.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Analysis:

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the House Committee on Rules to the Joint Committee on Ways and Means. The measure establishes a Small Donor Funded Elections program and establishes policies related to the new program, including setting caps for the maximum public match for elections through the 2018 general election. The measure also establishes the Small Donor Funded Elections Fund. It is anticipated that there is a fiscal impact associated with this bill, but the amount of this impact is still being determined. A more complete fiscal analysis on the bill will be prepared as the measure is considered in the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.
