WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:

Establishes the Oregon Department of Veterans' Affairs (ODVA) Advisory Committee Grant Fund separate from the General Fund. Permits ODVA to award grants of between \$25,000 to \$250,000 with Advisory Committee approval, for specified purposes. Provides for receipt of moneys from the Oregon State Lottery Fund established under Article XV, section 4(d) of the Oregon Constitution; moneys appropriated by the Legislative Assembly; interest earnings; donations; and other deposits from any source.
