Measure Description:

Renames offense of operating motor vehicle while using mobile communication device as offense of operating motor vehicle while using mobile electronic device.

Revenue Impact (in \$Millions):

This statement is issued to facilitate the referral of this measure to the committee on ways and means.

Impact Explanation:

SB 2 also increases the penalty to an A misdemeanor. It further increases the penalty to a C felony on the fourth conviction if the person has three prior convictions within 10 years. SB 2 requires the court to impose a minimum fine of \$1,000 on a first conviction, \$1,500 on a second conviction, and \$2,000 on a third or subsequent conviction if the person is not sentenced to imprisonment. It also establishes a maximum fine of \$10,000 if there is a minor passenger in the vehicle who is at least three years younger than the driver at the time of the offense. SB 2 imposes a mandatory
