Measure Description:

Allows tax credit for alternative energy device to be claimed by owner or subscriber of community solar project.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Department of Revenue(DOR), Department of Energy

Analysis:

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the House Committee on Energy and the Environment to the House Committee on Revenue. This bill allows the Residential Energy Tax Credit to be claimed by the owner or the subscriber of a community solar project. The addition of another class of taxpayer eligible to use this existing tax credit is unlikely to have any significant impact on workload for the Department of Revenue or Department of Energy. A more complete fiscal analysis on the bill will be prepared as the measure is considered in the House Committee on Revenue.
