Measure Description:

Modifies eligibility for Family Sentencing Alternative Pilot Program.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Department of Corrections, Department of Human Services (DHS), Department of Justice, District Attorneys and their Deputies, Judicial Department, Oregon Criminal Justice Commission, Public Defense Services Commission

Analysis:

The measure includes blank General Fund appropriations to the Department of Corrections, Department of Human Services, the Department of Justice, and the Criminal Justice Commission and has a blank Federal funds limitation for the Department of Human Services.

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the House Judiciary Committee to the Joint Committee on Ways and Means. A more complete fiscal analysis of the measure will be completed as the bill is considered in the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.
