Measure Description:

Directs Housing and Community Services Department to establish pilot program in which department constructs low-income senior housing development on school district land and school district rents to low-income seniors at reduced rent in exchange for classroom assistance.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Housing and Community Services Department, School Districts

Analysis:

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the House Committee on Human Services and Housing to the Joint Committee on Ways and Means. The bill directs the Housing and Community Services Department and school districts to develop and implement a low-income senior housing colocation pilot program. There will be a fiscal impact associated with this bill; the amount of this impact is still being determined. A more complete fiscal analysis on the bill will be prepared as the measure is considered in the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.
