Measure Description:

Makes changes to program requiring asbestos survey to have been conducted before demolishing residence or residential building.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Cities, Counties, Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ), Oregon Health Authority (OHA)

Analysis:

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the Senate Committee on Environment and Natural Resources to the Joint Committee on Ways and Means. The bill authorizes Cities to establish, by ordinance, a program for the demolition of residences or residential buildings, with certain stipulations. The Legislative Fiscal Office anticipates having a fiscal impact associated with this bill, and the amount of this impact is still being determined. A more complete fiscal analysis on the bill will be prepared as the measure is considered in the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.
