This statement is issued to facilitate the referral of this measure to the Committee on Ways and Means.

Impact Explanation:

Senate Bill 1023 creates a separate Deaf, Deaf-Blind, and Hard of Hearing Fund for DHS to use in administering programs for deaf, deaf-blind, or hard-of-hearing people. The measure also directs the Public Utility Commission to transfer a certain percentage of money from the Residential Service Protection Fund to the Deaf, Deaf-Blind, and Hard of Hearing Fund.

The impact of this measure will be further examined as the committee on Ways and Means considers this issue.
