### WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:

Requires school districts to allow use of school facilities by public school students and private tutors under certain circumstances. Allows schools to charge a fee of up to \$50 per year. Specifies that school policies must allow the use of school buildings both before and after school. Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2017.

#### **ISSUES DISCUSSED:**

- Local control
- School district policies
- Needs of students and families

#### **EFFECT OF AMENDMENT:**

Removes all requirements relating to libraries. Allows schools to charge a fee up to \$50 per year. Specifies that school policies must allow the use of school buildings both before and after school. Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2017.

#### **BACKGROUND:**

In December 2016, the Lake Oswego school district adopted a policy restricting private tutors from using school buildings. A similar policy has been adopted by the West Linn-Wilsonville school district. Portland Public Schools community use of buildings policies prohibit commercial enterprises from school buildings
