#### **Measure Description:**

Creates a refundable tax credit against personal income taxes for contributions to a 529 college savings account for certain tax payers. Creates a non-refundable tax credit for employers making 529 college savings contributions for their employees. Expands the tax subtraction for ABLE and Oregon 529 account contributions.
