Provides a child, ward, youth or youth offender who is 15 years old or older in the legal custody of the Department of Human Services the right to have access to certain confidential information maintained by the department. Allows child to sign release authorizing disclosure of information for the purpose of obtaining assistance from an advocate, attorney, legislator, or any other person.
