## WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:

Eliminates sunset on state preemption of local governmental authority to regulate work schedule requirements. Provides exceptions. Declares emergency, effective on passage.

## **ISSUES DISCUSSED:**

Need to refer to another committee

## **EFFECT OF AMENDMENT:**

No amendment.

## **BACKGROUND:**

In 2015, the Legislative Assembly enacted Senate Bill 968, preempting all local government authority to set requirements relating to work schedules before the date that the Legislative Assembly adjourns *sine die* the 2017 session. An exemption was included that allowed local governments to set such work schedule requirements for public employers and public contractors and subcontractors.

Senate Bill 329 makes permanent the state preemption of local governmental authority to regulate work schedule requirements.

This measure is being referred by the Senate Committee on Workforce to the Senate Committee on Rules.
