Measure Description:

Requires Oregon Health Policy Board, in collaboration with Office of Rural Health, to develop uniform application for all health care provider financial incentive programs and collect information from participants in programs.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Analysis:

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the House Committee on Health Care to the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.
