Measure Description:

Requires employer to pay employee equivalent of at least four hours of work if employee is scheduled or called in to work but, due to employer, does not work entire shift.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Bureau of Labor and Industries (BOLI), Oregon Health Sciences University (OHSU), Statewide

Analysis:

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the House Committee on Business and Labor to the House Committee on Rules. The bill relates to requirements of employers to compensate employees if an employee is scheduled, or called in to work, but due to the employer does not work an entire shift.
