WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:

Authorizes Governor to enter into agreement with another state for purpose of cross-jurisdictional coordination and enforcement related to marijuana-related businesses.

ISSUES DISCUSSED:

- Based on similar compact with Warm Springs Tribe
- How measure would effect the market

EFFECT OF AMENDMENT:

No amendment.

BACKGROUND:

Senate Bill 1042 authorizes the Governor or her designee to enter into an agreement with another state for purpose of cross-jurisdictional coordination and enforcement related to marijuana-related businesses. It also specifies requirements for entering into this agreement, such as that the border of the other state must abut the borders of this state. SB 1042 also specifies several modes of transportation that must be prohibited in the agreement, such as transportation of marijuana items through navigable airspace.
