Measure Description:

Authorizes State Board of Psychologist Examiners to issue certificate of prescriptive authority to licensed psychologist who meets specified requirements.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Board of Psychologist Examiners, Oregon Medical Board

Analysis:

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the House Committee on Health Care to the Joint Committee on Ways and Means. This bill authorizes the State Board of Psychologist Examiners to issue a certificate of prescriptive authority to licensed psychologists who meet the specified requirements and creates a nine-member Committee on Prescribing Psychologists. This bill will require the Board of Psychologist Examiners to hire additional staff. A more complete fiscal analysis on the bill will be prepared as the measure is considered in the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.
