# WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:

Requires applicants for initial license to practice respiratory therapy and for license by reciprocity to practice respiratory therapy to hold a credential as a Registered Respiratory Therapist. Clarifies respiratory therapy licensing process. Applies to applications received by the Health Licensing Office on or after the operative date of Act. Declares emergency, effective on passage.

#### **ISSUES DISCUSSED:**

- Certified respiratory therapist versus registered respiratory therapist (RRT)
- National Board for Respiratory Care national competency exam
- American Association for Respiratory Care trend to move to the RRT exam standards

# **EFFECT OF AMENDMENT:**

Clarifies respiratory therapy licensing process.

# **BACKGROUND:**

Respiratory care practitioners provide treatment to patients with abnormalities associated with the cardiopulmonary system — or breathing disorders — under the direction of a licensed physician. Respiratory care practitioners administer therapeutic or diagnostic drugs to patients as part of a physician-prescribed treatment plan, implement a physician's orders for respiratory treatments, observe and monitor patient symptoms and assist with administering medical gases (including hyperbaric or standard oxygen, vapor therapies and ventilation support).
