Requires Higher Education Coordinating Commission (HECC) to, on annual basis, work with Oregon Health and Science University, each public university, and each community college to determine number and graduation rates of former foster children and current foster children at each college or university. Requires HECC to make information available to public and to use information when conducting annual evaluation of public universities.

BACKGROUND:

Senate Bill 395 is being moved, without recommendation as to passage, to the Senate President's desk to be re-referred to a more appropriate committee.
