WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:

Requires drivers involved in an automobile accident to exchange the names of their respective insurance carriers and the applicable policy numbers associated with the vehicles involved in the accident.

ISSUES DISCUSSED:

• Currently no requirement in statute for drivers to exchange insurance information

EFFECT OF AMENDMENT:

No amendment.

BACKGROUND:

Under current law, all drivers involved in a motor vehicle accident are required to provide the other driver(s) involved in accident with their name, address, the registration number of their vehicle they were operating, and the name and address of any other occupants of the vehicle. Under current law, there is no requirement that drivers exchange information regarding their motor vehicle insurance coverage.
