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Measure Description:

Requires coordinated care organization to provide initial health screening to foster child no later than 60 days after child enrolls in coordinated care organization , whichever date is earlier.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Department of Human Services (DHS), Oregon Health Authority (OHA)

Analysis:
