# WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:

Requires Office of Manufactured Dwelling Park Community Relations to establish and administer landlord-tenant dispute resolution program. A tenant may participate in program, if notified of rent increase of more than one percent above OR-WA Consumer Price Index for all Urban Consumers for Housing, and majority of tenants agree to dispute increase. Specifies dispute resolution process.

### **EFFECT OF AMENDMENT:**

### **BACKGROUND:**

Created in 1989, the Office of Manufactured Dwelling Park Community Relations (Office) provides services to support improved landlord and tenant relationships and maintains a centralized resource referral program to encourage voluntary dispute resolution and directory of manufactured dwelling parks. The Office is funded through annual assessments: a \$10 assessment on each manufactured home on rented or leased land; a \$25 registration fee paid by landlords who have parks with 20 spaces or less; and \$50 registration fee for parks with more than 20 spaces.

House Bill 3331 requires the Office of Manufactured Dwelling Park Community Relations to establish and administer a landlord-tenant dispute resolution program. A tenant may participate in program, if notified of rent increase of more than one percent above OR-WA Consumer Price Index for all Urban Consumers for Housing, and majority of tenants agree to dispute increase.
