Recognizes and honors Corporal Robert "Bobby" Leon Jones (1983 - 2006) for his service to his country.

**ISSUES DISCUSSED:**

- Life and service of Corporal Jones

**EFFECT OF AMENDMENT:**

**BACKGROUND:**

Corporal Jones was born in Oregon City, Oregon on September 30, 1983. He moved with his family to Milwaukie and graduated from Rex Putnam High School in 2002. He joined the United States Army the following year and was assigned to the 40th Engineer Battalion based in Baumholder, Germany. He enjoyed camping, hunting, fishing, listening to music and spending time with his family. Corporal Jones aspired to open a business with his brother and buy a house for his parents when his military service was over. He was known for his practical jokes, constant grin, good nature, generosity, friendliness and for living according to his ideals. During his second tour in Iraq, he was killed in combat operations when an improvised explosive device detonated near his Humvee.
