Recognizes and honors Lance Corporal Dale G. Peterson, (1986-2007) for his service to his country.

ISSUES DISCUSSED:

- Life and service of Lance Corporal Peterson

EFFECT OF AMENDMENT:

No amendment.

BACKGROUND:

Lance Corporal Peterson was born September 7, 1986, in Bend, raised in Burns, and graduated from Redmond High School in 2005. He enlisted in the United States Marine Corps later that same year. He earned his Rifle Expert Badge and graduated with academic honors from the Basic Combat Engineer course. He enjoyed the outdoors, particularly the mountains, and working on old cars. He married in 2006, and his wife also later enlisted in the Marine Corps. Lance Corporal Peterson was attached to 2nd Battalion, 6th Marine Regiment during Operation Iraqi Freedom and deployed in March 2007. On April 23, 2007, he was killed when an improvised explosive device struck his vehicle while his squadron was on patrol in Fallujah, Iraq.
