Measure Description: Extends the operative date for the abolishment of the Oregon Medical Insurance Pool (OMIP) Account from July 1, 2017 to November 1, 2017. Continuously appropriates the remaining moneys in the account to the Oregon Department of Consumer and Business Services (DCBS).

Revenue Impact (in \$Millions): No Revenue Impact

Impact Explanation: If the HB 2391 becomes the law, the estimated \$50 million in the OMIP account will be transferred to the Health System Fund created under that bill. This money will be part of the operating funds to run the Oregon Reinsurance Program established under the same bill.
