Measure Description: Requires the Oregon Department of Education to develop a model plan (1) for conducting tests for certain environmental hazards in facilities owned or leased by a school district, an education service district or a public charter school where students or staff are present on a regular basis, and (2) for reporting such test results. Establishes the Healthy School Facilities Fund (HSFF) and transfers from the State School Fund to the HSFF, \$2 million each biennium starting from the 2019-21 school years.

Revenue Impact (in \$Millions): This bill does not change the formula revenue available for distribution to school districts and education service districts.

Impact Explanation: The newly created Healthy School Facilities Fund (HSFF) under this bill is funded by the State School Fund (SSF). While \$2 million per biennium is transferred to the HSFF from the SSF, the facility grants distributed from the SSF will be reduced from \$9 million to \$7 million per biennium. On net, the total off-the-top transfer or distribution from the SSF per biennium remains the same. Therefore, this bill does not change the total revenue to be distributed based on formula.
