WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:

Establishes limitations and deadlines for legislative measures for 2018 session of Seventy-ninth Legislative Assembly. Limits Senate members to no more than one measure draft and House members to no more than two measure drafts. Limits interim Senate and House committees to no more than three drafts. Limits Governor and Chief Justice to no more than five measure drafts. Requires all draft requests be submitted to Legislative Counsel on or before November 21, 2017 and all drafts to be filed at Senate or House desk no later than 5 p.m. on January 16, 2018. Exempts Joint Committee on Ways and Means, Senate President, and House Committee on Rules from limitations and deadlines.

ISSUES DISCUSSED:

- Effect of amendment

EFFECT OF AMENDMENT:

Limits members of Senate to one measure draft for the 2018 regular session.

BACKGROUND:

The 2012 Legislative Session was the first even-year regular session of the Oregon Legislative Assembly in the history of the state subsequent to the Oregon Constitution being amended by Measure 71 (2010). The even-numbered year short session is limited to 35 days, unless extended for five days by a two-thirds vote in each chamber. To assist in the administration of the short session, the legislature establishes measure limitations and introduction deadlines for measures that will be considered during the 2018 legislative session.

House Concurrent Resolution 40-A establishes deadlines and limitations for requesting and filing legislative measures for the 2018 session of Seventy-ninth Legislative Assembly.
