## House Bill 2015

Sponsored by Representative KOTEK, Senator FREDERICK, Representative GREENLICK; Representative KENY-GUYER

## **SUMMARY**

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure as introduced.

Directs Oregon Health Authority to reimburse doula at rate of no less than \$350 per pregnancy for services provided to medical assistance recipient.

1	A BILL FOR AN ACT
2	Relating to doulas.
3	Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
4	SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2017 Act is added to and made a part of ORS chapter 414.
5	SECTION 2. (1) As used in this section, "doula" means an individual who meets criteria
6	for a doula adopted by the Oregon Health Authority in accordance with ORS 414.665.
7	(2) The services described in subsection (3) of this section provided to a medical assist-
8	ance recipient must be reimbursed by the Oregon Health Authority at a rate of no less than
9	\$350 per pregnancy.
10	(3) The services reimbursed under subsection (2) of this section include:
11	(a) Support by a doula to a medical assistance recipient during labor and delivery; and
12	(b) Four home visits by a doula to the medical assistance recipient, including two
13	prenatal visits and two postpartum visits.
14	SECTION 3. The requirements of section 2 of this 2017 Act apply to services provided on
15	or after the effective date of this 2017 Act.

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
