## A-Engrossed House Bill 2027

## **SUMMARY**

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure.

[Authorizes issuance of lottery bonds to finance water storage projects and water distribution projects.]

[Establishes Water Storage Fund. Continuously appropriates moneys in fund to Water Resources Department.]

[Establishes Dry Day Subaccount. Continuously appropriates moneys in subaccount to Water Resources Department.]

[Declares emergency, effective on passage.]

Prohibits person, public body or local service district from constructing bridge on Deschutes River within certain segments of Deschutes Scenic Waterway.

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12 13 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

 $\underline{SECTION~1.}$  A person, a public body as defined in ORS 174.109 or a local service district as defined in ORS 174.116 may not construct a bridge on the Deschutes River within:

- (1) The segment of the Deschutes Scenic Waterway established under ORS 390.826 extending from the Deschutes National Forest boundary in section 20, township 19 south, range 11 east, Willamette Meridian, to the urban growth boundary of the City of Bend at river mile 172.
- (2) The segment of the Deschutes Scenic Waterway established under ORS 390.826 within the urban growth boundary of the City of Bend beginning at river mile 172 and extending downstream one mile to the Central Oregon Irrigation District's diversion structure at river mile 171.

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
