House Bill 2030

Sponsored by Representative CLEM (Presession filed.)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure as introduced.

Prohibits state agency from restricting or closing access to state lands used for hunting until state agency has notified State Department of Fish and Wildlife and department has posted notice of restriction or closure for at least 30 days on department's website. Provides exceptions.

2	Relating to hunting.
3	Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
4	SECTION 1. (1) A state agency may not restrict or close access to state lands that are
5	used for hunting until:
6	(a) The state agency has notified the State Department of Fish and Wildlife of the
7	agency's plans to restrict or close access to the lands; and
8	(b) A notice has been posted by the department on its website for at least 30 days that
9	informs the public of the state agency's plans to restrict or close access to the lands.
10	(2) Subsection (1) of this section does not apply to a restriction or a closure for:
11	(a) Fire prevention pursuant to ORS 477.535 to 477.550.
12	(b) A state of emergency declared pursuant to ORS 401.165 to 401.236.
13	(c) An emergency other than a state of emergency described in paragraph (b) of this
14	subsection.
