

House Bill 2044

Sponsored by Representative SMITH G (Pre-session filed.)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Prohibits Oregon Health Authority from recovering state's share of overpayment of medical assistance for prescription drug unless overpayment resulted from fraud.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to overpayments of medical assistance.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. An overpayment assessed by the Oregon Health Authority based on an audit**
5 **of a medical assistance claim for reimbursement of the cost of a prescription drug, other**
6 **than an overpayment resulting from fraud, must be reduced by the amount that the state**
7 **paid on the claim.**
