## **SUMMARY**

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure as introduced.

Directs Legislative Revenue Officer to report to interim committees of Legislative Assembly related to revenue on changes to law recommended by transient lodging tax work group. Takes effect on 91st day following adjournment sine die.

Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon: 4 5 SECTION 1. No later than February 1, 2018, the Legislative Revenue Officer shall report 6 to the interim committees of the Legislative Assembly related to revenue on the changes to 7 law recommended by the work group created by section 7, chapter 102, Oregon Laws 2016. 8 SECTION 2. Section 8, chapter 102, Oregon Laws 2016, is amended to read: 9 Sec. 8. Section 7 [of this 2016 Act], chapter 102, Oregon Laws 2016, is repealed on December 10 31, [2017] **2018**. 11 SECTION 3. This 2017 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the date on which the 2017 12 regular session of the Seventy-ninth Legislative Assembly adjourns sine die. 13
