## House Bill 2103

## **SUMMARY**

Permits licensed nurse practitioners to perform vasectomies.

3	Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
4	SECTION 1. ORS 435.305 is amended to read:
5	435.305. (1) A person may be sterilized by appropriate means upon request and upon the advice
6	of a physician licensed under ORS chapter 677 or physician assistant licensed under ORS 677.505
7	to 677.525.
8	(2) A health care provider described in [subsection (1) of] this section, or a hospital, may not be
9	held liable for performing a sterilization without obtaining the consent of the spouse of the person
10	sterilized.
11	(3) Free clinics to sterilize males under [subsection] subsections (1) and (4)(d) of this section
12	may be conducted as a part of the program provided for in ORS 435.205.
13	(4)(a) A nurse practitioner licensed by the Oregon State Board of Nursing under ORS 678.375
14	and acting within the scope of practice authorized by the board may provide medical advice to any
15	person about a sterilization procedure.
16	(b) A nurse practitioner may acknowledge and sign a consent to sterilization procedure form if,
17	no fewer than 30 days before the procedure, the form is provided to and signed by the person on
18	whom the procedure will be performed.
19	(c) A nurse practitioner may not acknowledge or sign a consent to sterilization procedure form
20	if the form is provided to or signed by the person on whom the procedure will be performed fewer
21	than 30 days before the procedure.
22	(d) A nurse practitioner may not perform a sterilization procedure on any person, except that
