

## HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 2114

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, line 2, after “drugs” delete the rest of the line and insert “; and  
2 prescribing an effective date.”.

3 Delete lines 4 through 30 and delete page 2 and insert:

4 **“SECTION 1. Not later than January 1, 2018, the Oregon Medical Board, the Oregon State  
5 Board of Nursing and the Oregon Board of Dentistry shall provide notice to the practitioners  
6 regulated by each board who are authorized under the laws of this state to prescribe opioids  
7 or opiates of the Oregon Opioid Prescribing Guidelines: Recommendations for the Safe Use  
8 of Opioid Medications, as endorsed by the Oregon Medical Board in January 2017.**

9 **“SECTION 2. As soon as practicable after the establishment of guidelines or recommen-  
10 dations as described in this section, the Oregon Medical Board, the Oregon State Board of  
11 Nursing and the Oregon Board of Dentistry shall provide notice to the practitioners regu-  
12 lated by each board who are authorized under the laws of this state to prescribe opioids or  
13 opiates of any guidelines or recommendations established by any association of practitioners  
14 whose members are regulated by the boards.**

15 **“SECTION 3. This 2017 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the date on which the 2017  
16 regular session of the Seventy-ninth Legislative Assembly adjourns sine die.”.**
