3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

4 **SECTION 1.** ORS 179.580 is amended to read:

5 179.580. (1) The Oregon State Hospital Advisory Board may establish ad hoc committees to aid

6 and advise the board in the performance of its functions. The chairperson of the board shall appoint

7 the chairperson of each committee. Each committee shall include no more than [two] one less than

8 a quorum of the voting members of the board, and the remaining members of a committee may not

- 9 be members of the board.
- 10 (2) Members of ad hoc committees are not entitled to compensation.
