House Bill 2139

Sponsored by Representative BOONE (Presession filed.)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure as introduced.

Directs State Department of Energy to study treating anhydrous ammonia as renewable energy source for purposes of renewable portfolio standard. Directs department to report on study to certain interim committees of Legislative Assembly on or before September 15, 2018.

Sunsets January 1, 2019.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

- 2 Relating to anhydrous ammonia.
 - Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
 - <u>SECTION 1.</u> (1) The State Department of Energy shall conduct a study on treating anhydrous ammonia as a renewable energy source for purposes of a renewable portfolio standard.
 - (2) The department shall submit a report with the results of the study, and may include recommendations for legislation, to the interim committees of the Legislative Assembly related to environment and natural resources in the manner provided under ORS 192.245 on or before September 15, 2018.
- 11 SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2017 Act is repealed on January 1, 2019.
