House Bill 2154

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure as introduced.

Directs Oregon State Lottery Commission to employ ombudsmen to assist small businesses that are or wish to become lottery game retailers or contractors.

- 2 Relating to small business ombudsmen for the Oregon State Lottery.
- 3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
 - SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2017 Act is added to and made part of ORS chapter 461.
 - <u>SECTION 2.</u> (1) The Oregon State Lottery Commission shall employ three small business ombudsmen.
 - (2) The small business ombudsmen shall assist small businesses that are or wish to become lottery game retailers or contractors. The assistance shall include:
 - (a) Receiving and answering questions relating to any aspect of the lottery;
 - (b) Guiding small businesses through the application process to become a lottery game retailer or contractor; and
 - (c) Assisting in resolving administrative, contractual or regulatory issues that may arise between small businesses and the commission.
 - (3) As used in this section, "small business" has the meaning given that term in ORS 56.200.
 - SECTION 3. Section 2 of this 2017 Act becomes operative on July 1, 2018.
 - SECTION 4. The Oregon State Lottery Commission may take any action before the operative date specified in section 3 of this 2017 Act that is necessary for the commission to carry out, on and after the operative date specified in section 3 of this 2017 Act, the duties imposed by section 2 of this 2017 Act.
