SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.**

Eliminates provision indicating that cannabis-related business licenses may be for term other than one year.

Qualifies provision providing that cannabis-related business license expires upon death of licensee.

[(6)] (5) If the license was issued to an individual, expires upon the death of the licensee, 15 except as provided in ORS 475B.033. 16 [(7)] **(6)** Does not constitute property. 17 [(8)] (7) Is not alienable. 18

[(9)] (8) Is not subject to attachment or execution.

[(10)] (9) Does not descend by the laws of testate or intestate devolution.
