## SENATE AMENDMENTS TO RESOLVE CONFLICTS TO HOUSE BILL 2220

1 On page 2 of the printed bill, after line 12, insert:

2 "<u>SECTION 2.</u> If House Bill 2314 becomes law, section 1 of this 2017 Act (amending ORS 3 332.114) is repealed and ORS 332.114, as amended by section 15, chapter \_\_\_\_, Oregon Laws 2017

4 (Enrolled House Bill 2314), is amended to read:

5 "332.114. (1) A person who meets the requirements under subsection (3) of this section may re-6 quest a school district to issue the person a high school diploma if the person resides within the 7 boundaries of the school district or is a resident of this state and attended a high school of the 8 school district.

9 "(2) A representative of a deceased person who meets the requirements under subsection (3) of 10 this section may request a school district to issue a high school diploma on behalf of the deceased 11 person if the deceased person resided within the boundaries of the school district at the time of 12 death or was a resident of this state at the time of death and attended a high school of the school 13 district.

"(3) Notwithstanding the requirements for a high school diploma established under ORS 329.451 and by the State Board of Education and school districts, a school district that receives a request under subsection (1) or (2) of this section shall issue a high school diploma to a person if the person: "(a) Attended a high school before serving in the Armed Forces of the United States;

"[(b) Did not graduate from a high school because the person was serving in the Armed Forces
of the United States;]

20 "[(c)] (b) Was discharged or released under honorable conditions from the Armed Forces of the 21 United States; and

"[(d)] (c) Served in the Armed Forces of the United States as described in subsection (4) of this
 section. [; and]

"[(e)(A) Has received a certificate for passing an approved high school equivalency test such as the
 General Educational Development (GED) test;]

26 "[(B) Has received a post-secondary degree from a community college, public university listed in 27 ORS 352.002 or other generally accredited institution of higher education; or]

28 "[(C) Has received a minimum score on the Armed Services Vocational Aptitude Battery (ASVAB),

29 as established by the Oregon Military Department.]

30 "(4) The provisions of subsection (3) of this section apply to a person who:

- 31 "(a) Served in the Armed Forces of the United States at any time during:
- 32 "(A) World War I;

33 "(B) World War II;

- 34 "(C) The Korean Conflict; or
- 35 "(D) The Vietnam War;

- 1 "(b) Served in the Armed Forces of the United States and was physically present in:
- 2 "(A) Operation Urgent Fury (Grenada);
- 3 "(B) Operation Just Cause (Panama);
- 4 "(C) Operation Desert Shield/Desert Storm (the Persian Gulf War);
- 5 "(D) Operation Restore Hope (Somalia);
- 6 "(E) Operation Enduring Freedom (Afghanistan); or
- 7 "(F) Operation Iraqi Freedom (Iraq); or
- 8 "(c) Served in the Armed Forces of the United States in an area designated as a combat zone
- 9 by the President of the United States.".
