SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure as introduced.

Increases application fee for individual who applies to be included on State Conciliation Service list of qualified arbitrators for labor controversy. Increases annual fee for individual to remain on State Conciliation Service list of qualified arbitrators for labor controversy.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

- 2 Relating to fees paid to State Conciliation Service by qualified arbitrators; amending ORS 662.445.
 - Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
- 4 **SECTION 1.** ORS 662.445 is amended to read:
- 662.445. (1) The State Conciliation Service shall maintain a list of qualified arbitrators who may be available to the parties to a labor controversy if the parties so request.
 - (2) An individual who applies to be included on the list of qualified arbitrators shall pay the State Conciliation Service an application fee of [\$50] \$100. A qualified arbitrator who is included on the list shall pay the State Conciliation Service an annual fee of [\$100] \$150 to remain on the list.
 - (3) Fees received by the State Conciliation Service under this section shall be deposited to the credit of the Employment Relations Board Administrative Account.
