Repeals requirement that Oregon Government Ethics Commission pay attorney fees for person prevailing in certain contested case hearings.

A BILL FOR AN ACT
Relating to Oregon Government Ethics Commission payment of attorney fees; creating new provisions; and repealing ORS 244.400.

Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

SECTION 1. ORS 244.400 is repealed.

SECTION 2. The repeal of ORS 244.400 by section 1 of this 2017 Act applies to the awarding of attorneys fees in cases filed on or after the effective date of this 2017 Act.
