

House Bill 2299

Introduced and printed pursuant to House Rule 12.00. Pre-session filed (at the request of Governor Kate Brown for Government Ethics Commission)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Repeals requirement that Oregon Government Ethics Commission pay attorney fees for person prevailing in certain contested case hearings.

4 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

5 **SECTION 1. ORS 244.400 is repealed.**

6 **SECTION 2. The repeal of ORS 244.400 by section 1 of this 2017 Act applies to the**
7 **awarding of attorneys fees in cases filed on or after the effective date of this 2017 Act.**
