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5	Delete lines 6 through 26 and delete pages 2 and 3 and insert: "SECTION 8. (1) The Mantel Health Clinical Advisors Courses is actablished in the Oregon
6 7	" <u>SECTION 2.</u> (1) The Mental Health Clinical Advisory Group is established in the Oregon
7	Health Authority. The Mental Health Clinical Advisory Group shall develop evidence-based algorithms for mental health treatments with mental health drugs based on:
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9	"(a) The efficacy of the drug; "(b) The cost of the drug;
10	"(b) The cost of the drug;
11	"(c) Potential side effects of the drug;
12	"(d) A patient's profile; and
13	"(e) A patient's history with the drug.
14	"(2) The Mental Health Clinical Advisory Group consists of 15 members appointed by the
15	authority as follows:
16	"(a) Two psychiatrists with active community practices;
17	"(b) One child and adolescent psychiatrist;
18	"(c) Two licensed clinical psychologists;
19	"(d) One psychiatric nurse practitioner with prescribing privileges;
20	"(e) Two primary care providers;
21	"(f) Two pharmacists, one of whom must have experience in dispensing to long term care
22	facilities and to patients with special needs;
23	"(g) Two individuals, representing statewide mental health advocacy organizations for
24	children and adults with mental illness, who have experience as consumers of mental health
25	services or as a family member of a consumer of mental health services;
26	"(h) Two individuals each representing a coordinated care organization; and
27	"(i) One consumer of mental health services or one family member of a consumer of
28	mental health services.
29	"(3) The Mental Health Clinical Advisory Group shall, in developing treatment algo-
30	rithms, consider all of the following:
31	"(a) Peer-reviewed medical literature;
32	"(b) Observational studies;
33	"(c) Studies of health economics;
34	"(d) Input from patients and physicians; and
35	"(e) Any other information that the group deems appropriate.

"(4) The Mental Health Clinical Advisory Group shall make recommendations to the au-1 2 thority and the Pharmacy and Therapeutics Committee including but not limited to: "(a) Implementation of evidence-based algorithms. 3 4 "(b) Any changes needed to any preferred drug list used by the authority. "(c) Practice guidelines for the treatment of mental health disorders with mental health 5 drugs. 6 7 (5) Recommendations of the Mental Health Clinical Advisory Group shall be posted to the website of the authority no later than 30 days after the group approves the recommen-8 9 dations. "(6) The Mental Health Clinical Advisory Group shall report to the interim committees 10 11 of the Legislative Assembly related to health: "(a) No later than December 31, 2017, its progress in developing evidence-based algo-1213rithms for mental health drugs; and "(b) No later than December 31, 2018, its final recommendations under subsection (4) of 14 this section and any legislative changes needed to fully implement the recommendations. 15"(7) A member of the Mental Health Clinical Advisory Group is not entitled to compen-16 sation but may be reimbursed for necessary travel expenses incurred in the performance of 1718 the member's official duties. "(8) The Mental Health Clinical Advisory Group shall select one of its members as 19 20 chairperson and another as vice chairperson, for terms and with duties and powers necessary 21for the performance of the functions of the group. 22"(9) A majority of the members of the Mental Health Clinical Advisory Group constitutes 23a quorum for the transaction of business. 24 "(10) The Mental Health Clinical Advisory Group shall meet at least once every two 25months at a time and place determined by the chairperson. The group also may meet at 26other times and places specified by the call of the chairperson or of a majority of the mem-27bers of the group. The group may meet in executive session when discussing factors listed in subsection (1) of this section. 28 29 "(11) In accordance with applicable provisions of ORS chapter 183, the Mental Health 30 Clinical Advisory Group may adopt rules necessary for the administration of this section. "(12) All agencies of state government, as defined in ORS 174.111, are directed to assist 31the Mental Health Clinical Advisory Group in the performance of duties of the group and, to 3233 the extent permitted by laws relating to confidentiality, to furnish information and advice 34the members of the group consider necessary to perform their duties. "SECTION 3. (1) As used in this section, 'mental health drug' means a type of legend 35 drug defined by the Oregon Health Authority by rule that includes but is not limited to: 36 37 "(a) Therapeutic class 7 ataractics-tranquilizers; and "(b) Therapeutic class 11 psychostimulants-antidepressants. 38 "(2) Notwithstanding ORS 414.334, the authority shall reimburse the cost of a mental 39 40 health drug prescribed for a medical assistance recipient if federal financial participation in 41 the cost is available. "SECTION 4. Section 3 of this 2017 Act becomes operative on January 2, 2018. 42"SECTION 5. (1) Section 2 of this 2017 Act is repealed on December 31, 2018. 43

44 "(2) Section 3 of this 2017 Act is repealed on January 2, 2020.

45 "<u>SECTION 6.</u> In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appro-

- 1 priated to the Oregon Health Authority, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2017, out of the
- 2 General Fund, the amount of \$143,888, which may be expended for carrying out section 2 of
- 3 this 2017 Act.

"<u>SECTION 7.</u> This 2017 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public
peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2017 Act takes effect
on its passage.".

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
