

House Bill 2300

Introduced and printed pursuant to House Rule 12.00. Pre-session filed (at the request of Governor Kate Brown for Oregon Health Authority)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Requires cost of mental health drugs to be taken into consideration in determining global budgets for coordinated care organizations.

2 Relating to prescription drug coverage for medical assistance recipients; amending section 13,
3 chapter 827, Oregon Laws 2009; and repealing ORS 414.742.

4 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

5 **SECTION 1. ORS 414.742 is repealed.**

6 **SECTION 2.** Section 13, chapter 827, Oregon Laws 2009, as amended by section 1, chapter 569,
7 Oregon Laws 2013, is amended to read:

8 **Sec. 13.** (1) The amendments to ORS 414.334 by section 10, chapter 827, Oregon Laws 2009, be-
9 come operative on January 2, 2014.

10 (2) The amendments to ORS 414.325 by section 8, chapter 827, Oregon Laws 2009, become op-
11 erative on January 2, 2018.

12 (3) **The repeal of ORS 414.742 by section 1 of this 2017 Act becomes operative on January**
13 **2, 2018.**
